The Treasure Hunt will start and finish in the school playground and will take approximately 45 minutes (taking into account little legs!). We want everyone to have fun and enjoy themselves but we also kindly ask that you remember the Countryside Code. The main trail crosses fields and stiles on public footpaths so is not suitable for pushchairs – we will have a shorter pushchair friendly trail available in the village centre. We recommend wellies and waterproofs!

Tickets cost £10 for a family of four, which includes the Treasure Hunt trail and a hot dog each at the end. Tea and coffee, and cake, will also be on sale at a small charge, with free squash for all the children. If you would like to donate cakes for the cake stall that would be very much appreciated.
