TRAVEL PLAN

As part of our school's Travel Plan, we are looking at ways of managing the parking of parents/ carers of children who attend St Peter's. As many of you will have seen, Mrs King has been out on the main road during drop off and pick up times this week and, on the whole, is delighted with how and where the vast majority of parents/ carers are parking. There are still a few vehicles that are being parked on the pavement outside Red Lion House and we would be very grateful if these parents/ carers could find alternative places to park however, it is great that so many are using The Plough and Church car parks and enjoying the short walk to school. Thank-you.

As part of our Travel Plan we need to find information about the number of vehicles that travel through Alvescot during the day. Unfortunately the last time that a survey of traffic through the village was conducted by Oxfordshire County Council was in 2003 so we now need to conduct our own traffic survey.

Next week, staff and children are going to be conducting a survey of the number of cars that travel through the Village. If you have an hour that you could spare to help us with this survey, we would be extremely grateful.

WALKING BUS
